Citi in Japan to open a child care center “Citi Kids Garden”

December 26, 2007, Tokyo – Citi announced today that it opened “Citi Kids Garden,” an in-house childcare center, in Citi’s Japan headquarters in Shinagawa, Tokyo, where childcare services are available for Citi employees with preschool children. Citi Kids Garden is the first of its kind for Citi in Japan, as a part of the company-wide effort to promote good work-life balance for its employees.

The Tokyo Metropolitan Government, which supports childcare facilities in the workplace, subsidized a part of construction and operational costs of Citi Kids Garden.

Representing Citi’s respect for diversity, any children regardless of place of birth, country of citizenship, and language are welcomed to Citi Kids Garden. Citi Kids Garden offers not only flexible services to meet various working styles but also bilingual environment to the children.

Occupying about 235 square meters on the first floor of the Citigroup Center, Citi Kids Garden has a child care room, a kitchen, restrooms, and office space. Currently approximately four licensed childcare staffs look after up to approximately 20 children. The basic service hours will be from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM, with extensions up to 10:00 PM. Citi Kids Garden will also furnish services such as dinner and between-meal snacks in accordance with the care schedule for the day. Citi Kids Garden plans to accept one-day use, depending on the number of regular children.

Poppins Corporation manages and provides the services at Citi Kids Garden. .

Citi Kids Garden is one of many examples that Citi has been advocating a good work-life balance for our working parents, including reduced working hours program and tele work program, baby-sitter services offered at discounted rates and distribution of childcare coupons.
