**Citi Holds its Third “Global Community Day”**  
**Citi Employees Volunteer in Community Activities around the World on the Same Day**

Citi will hold its third “Global Community Day” on Saturday, November 8, 2008. Global Community Day is an annual initiative in which Citi employees and their families participate in volunteer activities in order to make a difference in more than 100 countries where its employees live and work.

Global Community Day started in 2006 and this year marks its third anniversary. Last year, over 61,000 volunteers took part in some 1,000 events across 600 cities in 100 countries.

This year, local volunteer teams will be working in North America, Latin America, Asia Pacific, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa on a variety of projects addressing specific community needs including literacy, housing, environmental protection, nutrition, health care and disaster relief.

In Japan, a total of 47 projects will take place including environmental protection activities, such as the preservation of the World Heritage Kumano Ancient Road, the castle town in Tanba Sasayama, and the Takao Forest. Other activities include delivering financial education, promoting diversity, and collaborating with the United Nations’ World Food Programme.

“November 8th is a fabulous opportunity for Citi employees and their families to join hands in helping our communities away from our daily working life. With the participation of a number of our executives, this is also an important initiative to nurture a common culture for the organization,” said Douglas L. Peterson, Chairman, Representative Director, President & CEO of Nikko Citi Holdings Inc.
