**Citi Holds its Fourth “Global Community Day”
Citi Employees Volunteer in Community Activities around the World on the Same Day**

Citi will hold its fourth “Global Community Day” on Saturday, November 7, 2009. Global Community Day is an annual initiative in which Citi employees and their families participate in volunteer activities in order to make a difference to their local communities.

Global Community Day started in 2006 and this year marks its fourth anniversary. Last year, over 50,000 volunteers took part in some 1,100 events across 550 cities in 100 countries. This year, volunteer teams will be working in North America, Latin America, Asia Pacific, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa locally on a variety of projects addressing specific community needs including literacy, housing, environmental protection, nutrition, health care and disaster relief.

In Japan, a total of 22 projects will take place including environmental protection activities such as river clean-up at Arakawa, Tamagawa, Hozugawa, Okinawa beach clean-up, tree trimming and mowing in Tondabayashi, Osaka. Other activities include serving meals in Ueno Park, hiking and sports games with foster children.

“Global Community Day is a very popular event among employees of Citi Japan and I expect many employees and their families to join in and make this event an enjoyable and rewarding experience. As a member of the local community, Citi Japan strives to provide support for organizations that contribute to the areas where we work and live,” said Douglas L. Peterson, Chairman, Representative Director, President & CEO of Citigroup Japan Holdings Corp.

Takao (Tokyo), Cleaning up at Tamagawa River (Kanagawa), Cleaning up at a guide dog training center (Kanagawa), Recreation activities with the challenged children (Kanagawa)
- **Kansai Area**: Cleaning up at Hozugawa River (Kyoto), Tree thinning in Tondabayashi (Osaka), Blood donation (Osaka)
- **Okinawa Area**: Cleaning up one of Okinawa's beaches
- **Nation-wide**: Collecting used stamps, Collecting PET bottle caps
