**Citi Holds its Fifth “Global Community Day”  
Citi Employees Volunteer in Community Activities around the World on the Same Day  
Over 1,300 Citi Employees and Their Families Contribute at 25 Events Across Japan**

Citi will hold its fifth “Global Community Day” on Saturday, October 23, 2010. Global Community Day is an annual initiative in which Citi employees and their families participate in volunteer activities in order to make a difference in their local communities.

Global Community Day commenced in 2006 and this year marks its fifth anniversary. This year, we expect 45,000 employee volunteers to participate in 950 projects in more than 75 countries around the world. Volunteer teams will be working in North America, Latin America, Asia Pacific, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa on a variety of projects addressing specific community needs including literacy, housing, environmental protection, nutrition, health care and disaster relief.

In Japan, more than 1,300 employees and their families will volunteer at 25 projects spanning the country, including activities with environmental themes such as river clean-ups at Arakawa (Tokyo), Tamagawa (Kanagawa), Kamogawa and Hozugawa (Kyoto), beach clean-up and coral planting (Okinawa), and other activities including painting shoe boxes and laminating educational materials at a school for challenged children (Tokyo) and hiking with children from a foster home (Ibaraki).

“Global Community Day is one of the events that many employees in Citi Japan, including myself, look forward to participating in every year. Global Community Day is also an excellent opportunity for us to come together both in Japan and around the world to show our unified support for the community. Citi strives to embrace the responsibility to make a difference where our employees live and work,” said Darren Buckley, Representative Director, President & CEO of Citigroup Japan Holdings Corp.

### **Programs in Japan**

- **Kanto Area** : Hiking with children from a foster home (Ibaraki), creating Christmas gifts, antisepticing toys and sterilizing tableware at a residence for seriously ill children and their families (Tokyo), supporting sales of cookies baked at a social work center (Tokyo), donating books and learning about an institution that develops libraries and schools in developing countries, participating in a painting workshop to help children in need, supporting an autumn festival at a welfare center (Tokyo), painting shoe boxes, laminating educational materials at a school for challenged children(Tokyo), donating picture story books with translation stickers (Tokyo), taking care of seedlings in the gardens of Meiji Jingu Shrine (Tokyo), cleaning up the Arakawa River (Tokyo) and Tamagawa River (Kanagawa), blood donation (Tokyo), playing futsal with homeless people and cleaning up a guide dog training center (Kanagawa).
- **Chubu Area**: Supporting a charity run for the Special Olympics (Aichi)
- **Kansai Area**: Cleaning up the Kamogawa River and Hozugawa River (Kyoto), and blood donation (Osaka)
- **Okinawa Area**: Beach clean-up, coral planting (Okinawa)
- **Nation-wide**: Collecting used stamps, Collecting PET bottle caps
